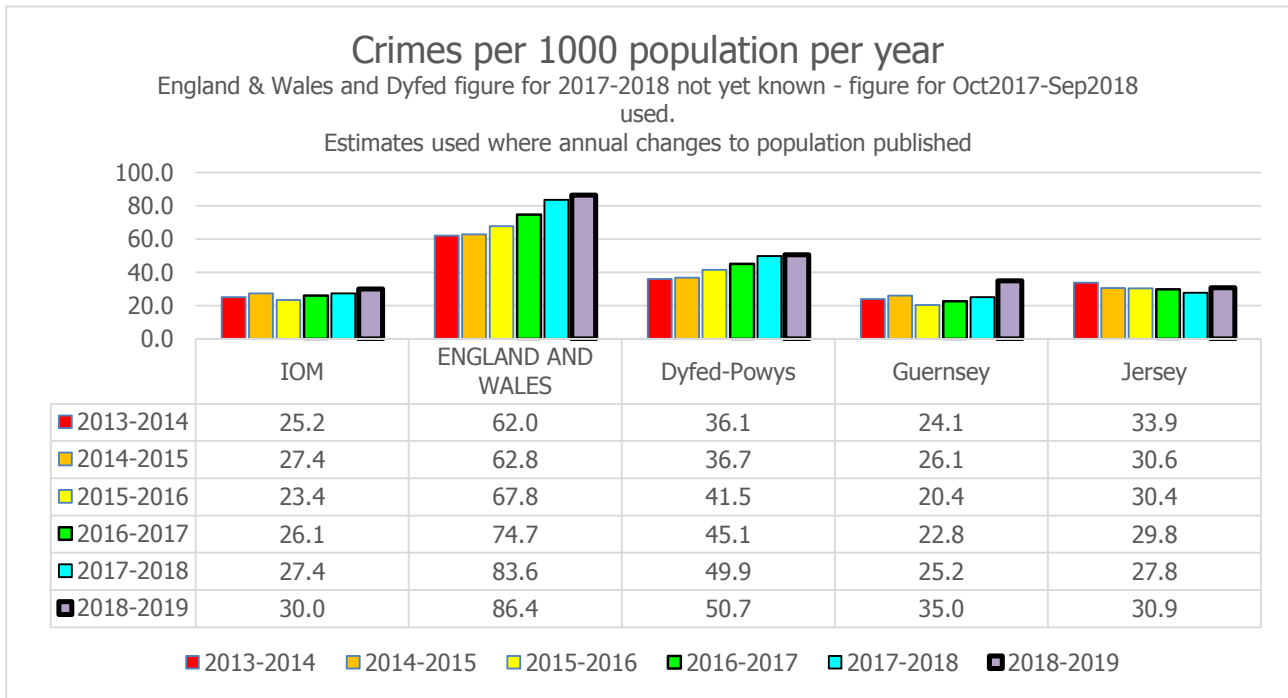


CRIME COMPARISON WITH OTHER JURISDICTIONS



- The tables should be viewed as merely indicative, in view of the fact that there are recording anomalies between different jurisdictions. For example, the recording of public order offences differs. Such offences are recorded as crimes here, yet not in the Channel Islands and laws vary across the different jurisdictions.
- Guernsey's detection rate has dropped sharply in same year as recorded crimes have increased, and a principal factor in this is the change to a new crime recording system and management, rather than any real change to effectiveness of policing.
- Populations are based on the most recent available Census information. Figures for England and Wales for all of 2018-2019 (figures are available for October 2017 to September 2018) will not be available until around July 2019. It is likely that England and Wales figure will still be in excess of 80 crimes per 1000 population per year.
