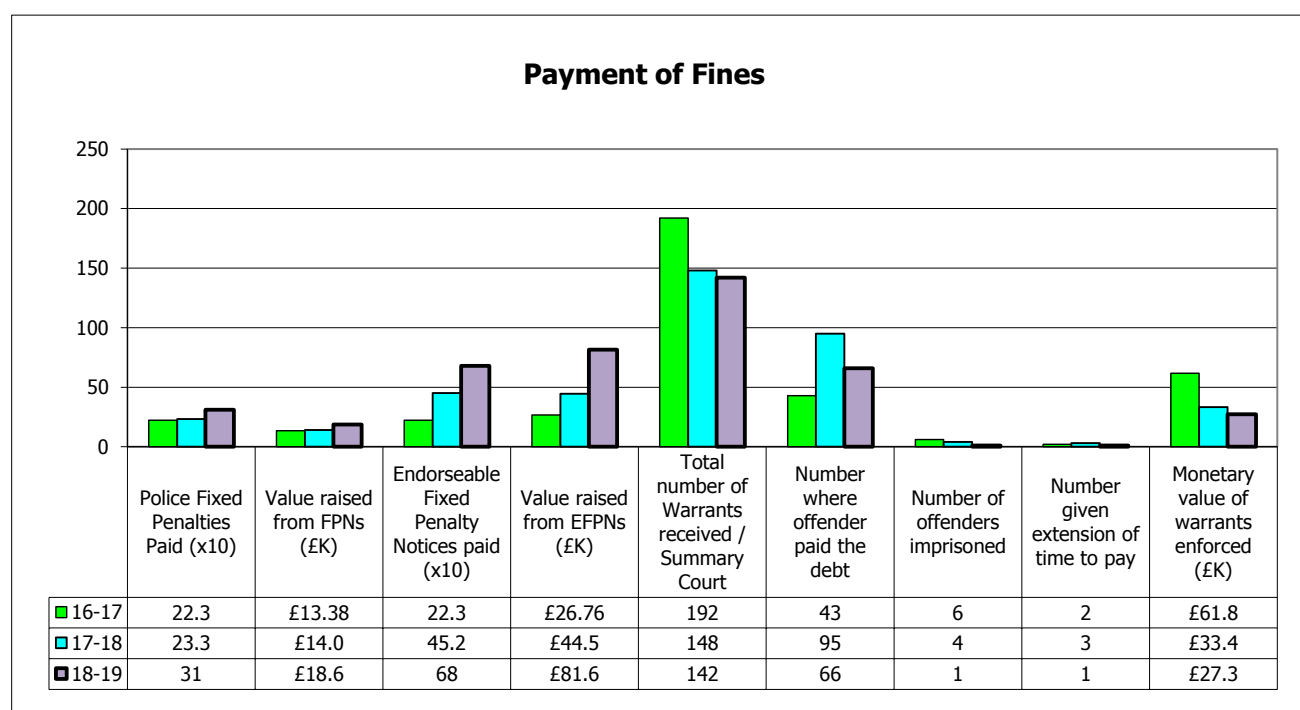

- The data shows that the use of endorseable fixed penalty notices (EFPNs) increased during the year. All officers have now been trained in their use and they are being used more widely than before. Importantly, the extra use has not been accompanied by an alteration in our attitude towards the public: notices will be used in cases where a prosecution is warranted, not as a means to generate revenue¹.

¹ Money generated from fines and EFPNs goes into the government's general revenue account and not to the Constabulary
