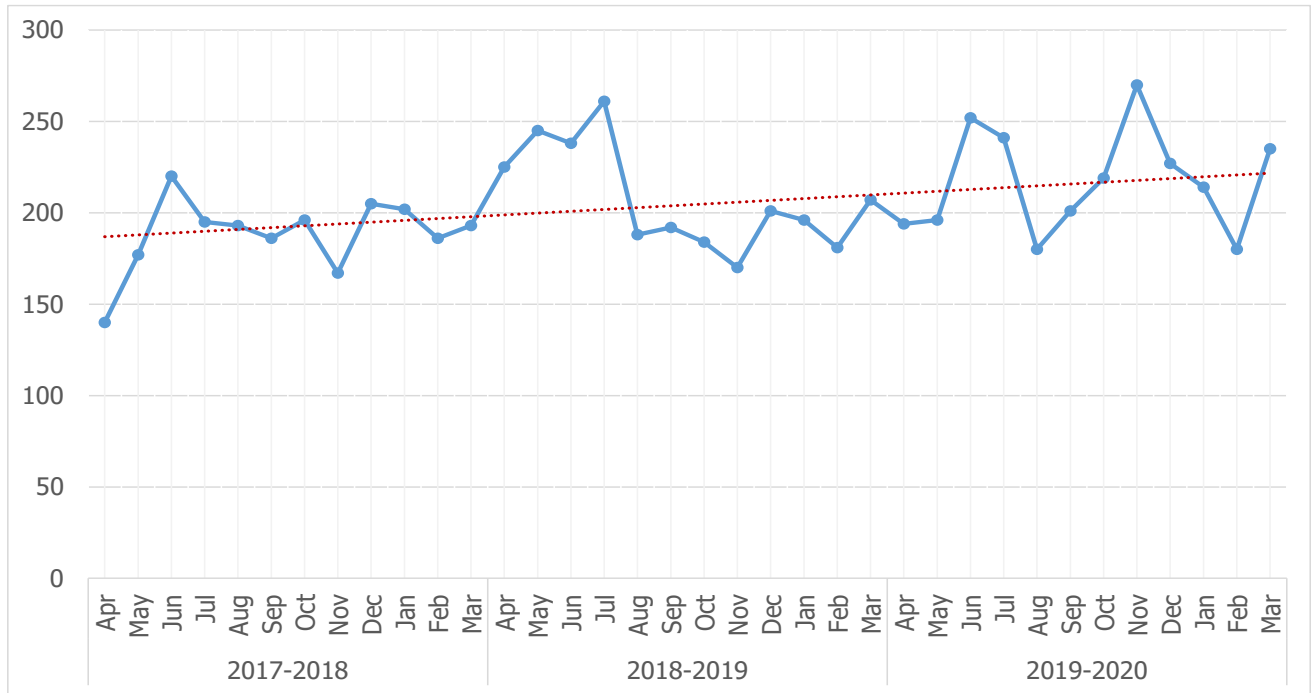


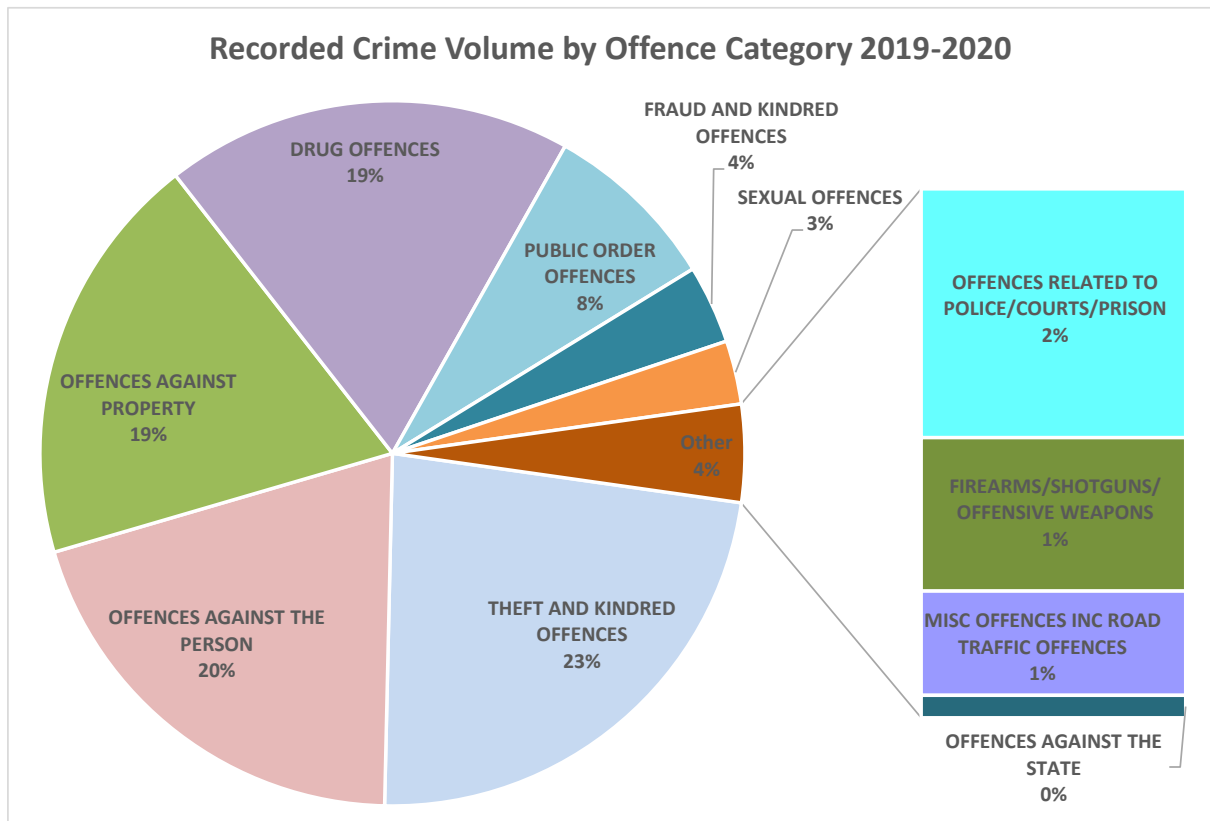
ALL ISLAND RECORDED CRIME

The following charts show the total number of crimes recorded each month over the past three years, and a table to show detection rate. The following pages give a breakdown for each offence type and their detection rates over the past 3 crime years. For a description of recorded crime and detection rate please see [Annex A](#).

Recorded crime increased by 4.9% when compared to 2018-19. The rise compared to last year is predominantly due to increases in recording of Offences against the Person and Fraud Offences. [Annex B](#) contains a detailed breakdown of all recorded crime. There was a decrease in the overall detection rate of 2.2%.



The above chart shows the volume of recorded crime by offence category. Theft and kindred offences, offences against the person, offences against property and drug offences each make up roughly one fifth of the crimes recorded in 2019-20.
