PAYMENT OF FINES

The Constabulary issue Fixed Penalty Notices (FPNs) for issues such as parking offences, Endorsable Fixed Penalty Notices (EFPNs) for driving offences that can also carry points on the driving licence, such as speeding, and also pursue offenders who have not paid fines, for whom a Non Payment of Fines Warrant (NPW) has been issued by the Summary Court. The value of fines given as a result of a prosecution at court, or issued as a FPN by Parking Controllers, which are paid promptly by the offender, do not figure in below tables.
