

**NON CRIME INVESTIGATIONS:  
ROAD TRAFFIC COLLISIONS**

The number of Road Traffic Collisions recorded decreased by 10% when compared to 2018-19, with decreases in less serious incidents across the last three years. The table below shows the number of incidents by their level of seriousness over the past three years.

The map on the following page shows the locations of these road traffic offences, and their seriousness.

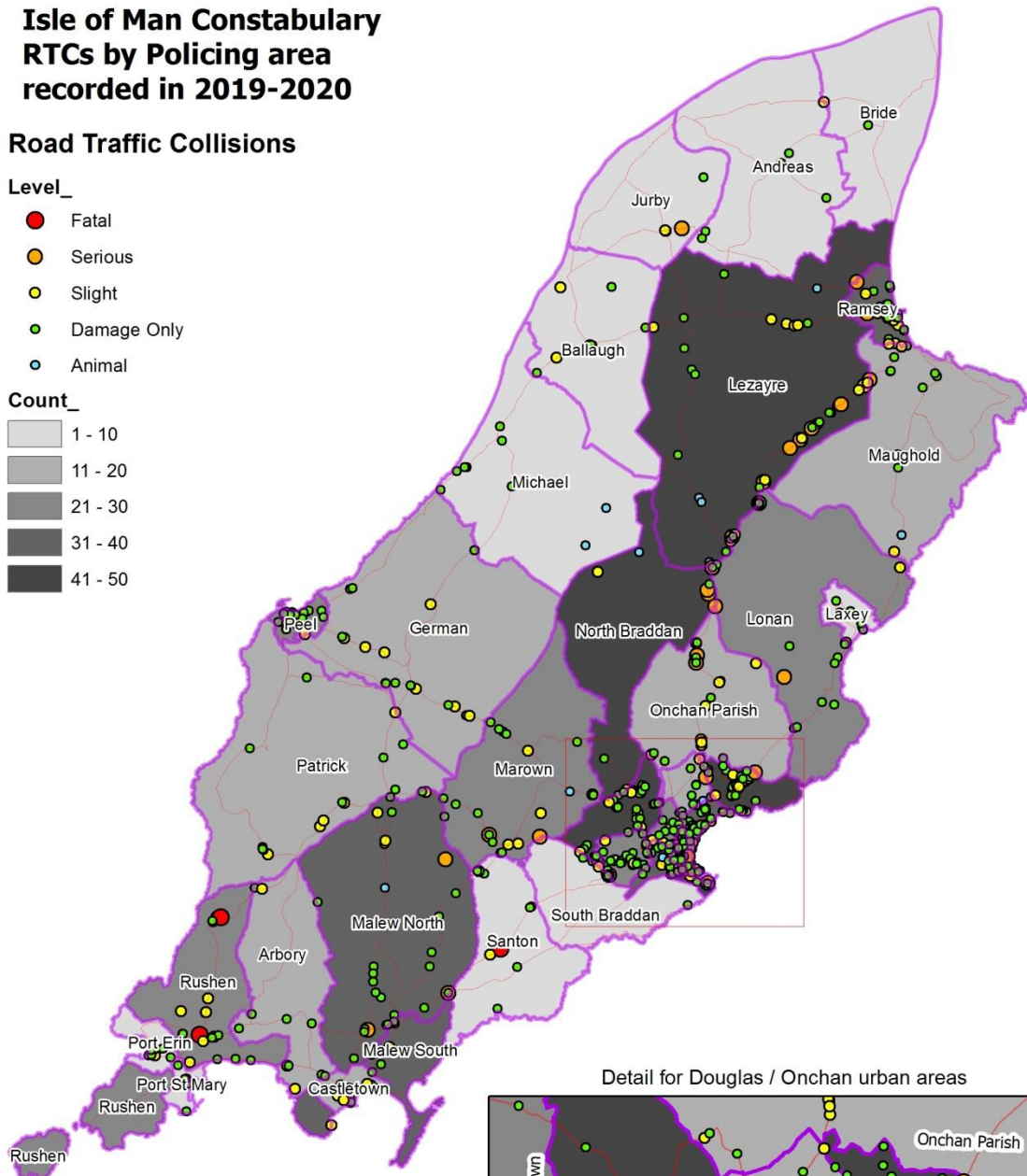

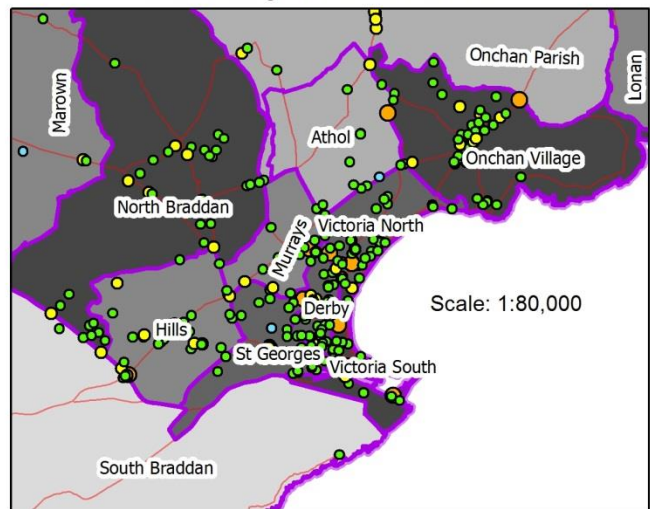
